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DWC Posts Draft Physician Reporting and Utilization Review Regulatory Amendments to Online Forum for Public Comment

The Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) has posted a draft of amendments to the physician reporting and utilization review regulations on its <u>online forum</u>, and invites members of the public to review and provide comment.

The proposed changes, which will update the treating physician reporting requirement and implement the provisions of <u>Senate Bill 1160</u>, are intended to:

- Expedite appropriate evidence-based medical treatment for injured workers
- Increase meaningful communication between treating physicians and utilization review physicians, and
- Improve the overall quality of utilization review services in workers' compensation.

The proposed regulatory amendments will be made pursuant to the rulemaking provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act.
