John Cortes. I am an Industrial Relations Counsel for the

Division of Workers' Compensation.

Before we begin today's conference call public hearing, I want to inform everyone that this call is being recorded. I also want to ask if anyone wishes to make a public comment today. If you do, can you please give us your full name, the organization you are affiliated with, if any, and contact information in case we need to provide you with any updates. We prefer an e-mail address, but if you don't have an e-mail address, your phone number or mailing address would be fine. Maureen Gray, DWC's Regulations Coordinator, who is also on this call, will write down your information.

Okay. Does anyone wish to make a public comment today? If you could please give your name to Maureen Gray, that would be great. Let me give you a second for anyone to speak up if they want to make a public comment today. Okay. Let me just say if you are undecided at this time but change your mind during the hearing and wish to speak, I will give you an opportunity to make a public comment after everyone on this list has spoken.

Before we begin, I want to ask everyone to please

press their respective mute buttons to minimize unintended background noises. Please press unmute when you wish to speak and make sure to state your name before you begin speaking for our hearing reporter.

Okay. So why don't we get started. Thank you for participating in today's conference call. Again, my name is John Cortes. I am an Industrial Relations Counsel for the Division of Workers' Compensation. This is our noticed conference call public hearing for the evidence-based update to the Medical Treatment Utilization Schedule, also known as the MTUS. The Division is proposing to make an evidence-based update to the MTUS by adopting the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine, or essentially known as ACOEM's Initial Approaches to Treatment Guideline.

Now, I'd like to take a moment to introduce the other DWC staff members on this conference call today.

As I've mentioned, I'm joined by Maureen Gray, the Division's Regulations Coordinator. Also on the call is George Parisotto, the DWC's Administrative Director, and our hearing reporter today is Dora Ocegueda. Now, unfortunately Dr. Raymond Meister, the DWC's Executive Medical Director, is unable to join us this morning. He is usually with us during the MTUS public hearings.

So let me just go ahead and say the purpose of this

hearing is to receive comments on the proposed amendment to the regulations, and we welcome any comments you have about them. Please note, we will not ask questions, respond to or discuss anyone's comments, although we may ask for clarification or ask you to elaborate further on any points that you are presenting. All of your comments, both given verbally here today and those submitted in writing, will be considered in determining what revisions, if any, we make to the proposed regulations.

Please restrict the subject of your comments to the proposed regulations. Now, we usually ask that you limit your comments to three minutes in length. However, we don't have anyone as of yet who has signed up, so if someone does wish to make a comment today, I will allow you to speak beyond the normal three minutes and give you a reasonable amount of time to make your comment.

I will call the names of those who have indicated they wish to comment today, and I apologize in advance if I mispronounce anyone's name. All testimony today will be transcribed by the hearing reporter. She has the green light to interrupt the commenter, to request the spelling of a word, seek clarification, if any, or ask a speaker to slow down if need be.

When everyone on this list has had a chance to make their public comment, I will check to see if anybody

new has joined our call or wants to speak or if anybody else has additional comments. This hearing will continue for as long as there are people on this call who wish to comment on the proposed regulations, but it will close at 5:00 o'clock this afternoon. If the hearing continues into the lunch hour, we will take at least an hour break.
