## Electronic Adjudication Management System E-Forms Trial Additional Conditions #2 Regarding Signatures May 18, 2010

Pursuant to paragraph 26 of the Electronic Adjudication Management System E-Forms Trial Application and Agreement, the Division of Workers' Compensation imposes the following additional conditions on the e-forms trial regarding signatures.

E-forms which require either the injured worker's or employer's signature: Application for Discretionary Payments from the Uninsured Employers Fund, Notice of Offer of Modified or Alternate Work, Supplemental Job Displacement Nontransferable Training Voucher Form, Notice of Offer of Regular Work, Employee's Disability Questionnaire or which require more than one (1) signature shall have the actually signed EAMS OCR forms attached to the e-form.

All other e-forms shall use an "S signature" format in lieu of a handwritten signature. An S signature shall consist of the letter S followed by the first and last name of the person signing the document, in the following format: S JOHN JONES.

The S signature shall be rebuttably presumed to be that of the individual whose name is on the document signature line.

The S signature may also be used only on the 8 Cal Code Reg §§ 10770.5 and 10770.6 lien verifications and any proof of service.

Effective as of the date of notice of this E-Forms Trial Additional Conditions #2, the S signature verification is no longer necessary.
