17 WHEREAS, Respondents stipulated to debarment as follows:

21 Country Builders, Inc;
- 22 3. Respondents entered into the attached Addendum to Stipulation in
23 the case of People v. Country Builders, Inc, et al, Alameda County
24 Superior Court Case No. RG 10501786;
- 25 4. Based on the Addendum to Stipulation, Respondents shall be
26 ineligible for a period of three years, beginning March 1, 2011 to
27 do either of the following:
28 A) bid on or be awarded a contract for a public works
project; or
