- 20 Whereas, Respondent stipulated to debarment as follows:

 - 22 2. Doug Parks and Son Plumbing is the holder of California Contractor's license
23 No. 411825.
 - 24 3. Respondent entered into the attached Stipulation for Debarment.
 - 25 4. Based on the Stipulation for Debarment, Respondent, and any firm,
26 corporation, or association in which Respondent has any interest as defined in
27 Labor Code section 1777.1(h), or any substantial interest as defined in the
28 California Code of Regulations, Title 8, section 16800, shall be ineligible for a


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period of two years, effective sixty (60) days following the date of signature
of this order, to do either of the following:
a. Bid on or be awarded a contract for a public works project as defined by
Labor Code sections 1720, 1720.2, and 1720.3; or
b. Perform work as a subcontractor on a public works project as defined by
Labor Code sections 1720, 1720.2, and 1720.3.

This order is effective sixty (60) days after it is signed.
