Citation 1 Item 1 Type of Violation: **Regulatory**

California Code of Regulations, Title 8: Section §14300.4. Recording Criteria.

(a) Basic requirement. Each employer required by this article to keep records of fatalities, injuries, and illnesses must record each fatality, injury and illness that:

- (1) Is work-related; and
- (2) Is a new case; and
- (3) Meets one or more of the general recording criteria of Section 14300.7 or the application to specific cases of Section 14300.8 through Section 14300.12.

VIOLATION:

Prior to and during the course of the inspection, including but not limited to January 12, 2021, the employer did not record work-related illnesses, meeting the general recording criteria of Section 14300.7 on its Cal/OSHA Log 300 as required by this section.

California Code of Regulations, Title 8: Section §3205. COVID-19 Prevention.

(c) Written COVID-19 Prevention Program. Employers shall establish, implement, and maintain an effective, written COVID-19 Prevention Program, which may be integrated into the employer's Injury and Illness Program required by section 3203, or be maintained in a separate document. The written elements of a COVID-19 Prevention Program shall include:

(7) Face coverings.

(A) Employers shall provide face coverings and ensure they are worn by employees over the nose and mouth when indoors, when outdoors and less than six feet away from another person, and where required by orders from the CDPH or local health department.

VIOLATION:

Prior to and during the course of the inspection, including, but not limited to, on January 12, 2021, the employer failed to ensure that employees were wearing face coverings over their nose and mouth when working indoors.
