**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

WHEREAS, on or about August 5, 2022, Respondent Jesus Alvarez pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles and

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(B) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or who has been suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

WHEREAS, Jesus Alvarez was suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner or provider whose license, certification, or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

1           WHEREAS, on or about March 22, 2023, Jesus Alvarez’s license, certification or  
2 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the California  
3 Board of Registered Nursing, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

4           WHEREAS, on or about August 8, 2023, the Administrative Director mailed to Jesus  
5 Alvarez a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the  
6 procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2)  
7 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

8           WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of  
9 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Jesus Alvarez that the  
10 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice,  
11 unless Jesus Alvarez submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar  
12 days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

13           WHEREAS, Jesus Alvarez did not submit a written request for hearing within ten  
14 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

15           WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,  
16 practitioner or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of  
17 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was  
18 mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a  
19 hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

20           **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Jesus Alvarez is hereby suspended  
21 from participating in the workers’ compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or  
22 provider.
