Research Question	Method
In what settings do fire equipment mechanics typically work?	Worksite mapping — review of public data sources; discussions with union and employer reps, professional orgs
Can we determine how many mechanics there are in California?	
What job tasks and activities could lead to exposure to carcinogens or other toxic substances?	Worksite visits — up to 12 locations in Los Angeles County
	Interviews — 10 key informants outside of Los Angeles County
What levels of exposure are found in these job tasks and activities?	Environmental sampling — 25-30 workers in Los Angeles County
How prevalent are these job tasks and activities among mechanics across the state?	Worker survey — up to 100 current and former workers across the state
What health outcomes reported by mechanics could be linked to occupational exposures?
