**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

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WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

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WHEREAS, on or about August 16, 2022, Respondent Justin Heiser Donahue (Justin Donahue) pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the Superior Court of California, County of Monterey; and

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WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(B) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider who has been suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

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WHEREAS, Justin Donahue was suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

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WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification,

1 or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

2 WHEREAS, on or about April 20, 2023, Justin Donahue license, certification, or  
3 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Board of  
4 Registered Nursing, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

5 WHEREAS, on or about June 4, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to Justin  
6 Donahue a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the  
7 procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2)  
8 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of  
10 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Justin Donahue that the  
11 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice,  
12 unless Justin Donahue submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar  
13 days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

14 WHEREAS, Justin Donahue did not submit a written request for hearing within ten  
15 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

16 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,  
17 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of  
18 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was  
19 mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a  
20 hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

21 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Justin Donahue is hereby suspended  
22 from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or  
23 provider.
