**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

**FARAMARZ FRED KHALILI,  
Respondent.**

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Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation (Administrative Director) to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the California workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual or entity has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor and that crime either: (1) involves fraud or abuse of the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs, the Medi-Cal program, or the workers' compensation system, or fraud or abuse of any patient; (2) relates to the conduct of the individual's medical practice as it pertains to patient care; or (3) is a financial crime that relates to the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs, the Medi-Cal program, or the workers' compensation system.

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Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the California workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked.

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On or about September 27, 1996, Respondent Faramarz Fred Khalili (Khalili) was convicted in the United States District Court, Central District of California, of crimes described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A). (United States of America v. Faramarz Fred Khalili, Case No. CR 98-14-DDP.)

1 On or about February 28, 2013, Respondent Khalili's license, certification or  
2 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Board of  
3 Chiropractic Examiners of California, Department of Consumer Affairs.

4 On or about November 15, 2022, the Administrative Director mailed to  
5 Respondent Khalili a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension  
6 and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section  
7 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1.

8 Pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,  
9 title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Respondent Khalili that the  
10 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written  
11 notice, unless Respondent Khalili submitted a written request for a hearing within ten  
12 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice.

13 Respondent Khalili did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)  
14 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice.

15 The Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or  
16 provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of Regulations,  
17 title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless  
18 the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten  
19 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice.

20 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Faramarz Fred Khalili is hereby  
21 suspended from participating in the California workers' compensation system as a  
22 physician, practitioner, or provider.
