9 **ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

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11 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director
12 to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'
13 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been
14 convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A);
15 and

16 WHEREAS, on or about July 24, 2018, Respondent Farhat Fatima Khan (Farhat
17 Khan) pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described
18 in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the Superior Court of California, County of San
19 Diego; and

20 WHEREAS, on or about May 21, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to Farhat
21 Khan a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure
22 to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and
23 California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

24 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of
25 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Farhat Khan that the
26 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice,
27 unless Farhat Khan submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days
28 of the date of mailing of the notice; and

1 WHEREAS, Farhat Khan did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
2 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

3 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,
4 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of
5 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was
6 mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a
7 hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

8 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Farhat Khan is hereby suspended from
9 participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
