ORDER OF SUSPENSION

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WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification, or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 6, 2018, Respondent Bobby R. Miller, Jr.'s (Bobby Miller Jr.) license, certification, or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Medical Board, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, on or about March 18, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to Bobby Miller, Jr., a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Bobby Miller, Jr., that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Bobby Miller, Jr., submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Bobby Miller, Jr., did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and
