Dear Mr. Rich:

As you may know, the Director of Industrial Relations has just adopted a series of amendments to the regulations governing labor compliance programs (LCPs) as well as new regulations governing fee-based compliance monitoring and enforcement by this Department. The amendments and new regulations become effective on **August 1, 2010**.

We want to take this opportunity to notify you of a specific change affecting your program which can be found in Title 8, California Code of Regulations, section 16431, governing the filing of annual reports. Section 16431 was amended to require all programs to report on a July to June fiscal year basis (which was the rule prior to 2004). The due date for annual reports will be August 31 of each year.

The newly-adopted amendments also authorize the Director to require the filing of an interim or supplemental report in order to cover any gap between a program's former reporting period and the new uniform fiscal year reporting period.

Our records show that your program's most recent annual report covered the period of **May 1, 2009 to April 30, 2010**. In order to bring your reports into alignment with the new uniform fiscal year reporting period, we ask that you submit an interim report covering the period from **May 1, 2010 to June 30, 2010** only. Please file this interim report by no later than **November 1, 2010**. Once your interim report has been filed, your next annual report will be for the July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011 fiscal year and will be due by August 31, 2011.

The annual report format has not changed. You can submit your intertim report on the appropriate annual report form, but be sure to indicate the interim period that your report covers. The forms are available for download at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/lcp/LCPReporting.htm>.

Also, the Department will be posting labor complianced annual reports on its website beginning in early August. This will allow members of the public to view reports submitted on behalf of your

program. We will post annual reports for the reporting period 2009 through 2010 and going forward on an annual basis.


