The DAS website should have a portal that is available to contractors that allows them to research which Apprenticeship Programs they must submit their DAS140/DAS142 (if they are not approved to train) for EACH CRAFT. The current Apprenticeship Program website lists many apprenticeship training programs imbedded within the general craft's training jurisdiction, but this confuses the novice contractor. E.g. There should be a pull down option for "Brick Tenders," "Plaster Tenders" separate / apart from its current location under the "Laborer" option.
