LABOR AGREEMENT

between

**California Lathing & Plastering Contractors' Association,
Sacramento Chapter, Inc.**

and

**Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons'
Local Union No. 300**

of the

**Operative Plasterers' and Cement Masons'
International Association of the United States
and Canada, AFL-CIO**

Effective
July 1, 2009 - June 30, 2013

(c) Area No. 295 (Sacramento), Area No. 355 (Santa Rosa) and Area No. 429 (Modesto). Eligibility for travel pay shall be determined by the distance to the jobsite from the Local Area Union Hall from which the employee was dispatched. No travel pay shall be paid for distances up to forty (40) miles.

(1) For travel to jobs anywhere except to jobs within the Four Counties (Alameda, Contra Costa, San Francisco and San Mateo Counties), travel pay shall be paid as follows:

Up to 40 miles	Free zone
40.1 to 60 miles	\$25.00 per day
60.1 to 100 miles	\$50.00 per day
100.1 and over	\$80.00 per day

(2) For travel to jobs within the Four Counties (Alameda, Contra Costa, San Francisco and San Mateo Counties), travel pay shall be paid as follows:

Up to 40 miles	Free zone
40.1 to 60 miles	\$25.00 per day
60.1 and over	\$50.00 per day

(3) If the employer provides transportation to the job, the travel pay set forth above in (1) and (2) shall be reduced by \$10.00 per day.

(o) **Parking.** Where parking is restricted within a three (3) block radius of the jobsite, the Employer shall pay all Plasterers for parking, upon presentation of a validated parking receipt. This section shall not apply where the Employer provides parking within the three (3) block radius of the jobsite.
