**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES
AND ALL INTERESTED PARTIES REGARDING MODIFICATIONS
TO THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

Dear Public Official/ Other Interested Parties:

The following are modifications of the predetermined increases for the craft/classification(s) listed below:

CRAFT/CLASSIFICATIONS: Carpet, Linoleum, Soft Floor Layer
Floor Covering Handler after 3 years
Floor Covering Handler Less Than 3 Years
Floor Covering Handler Trainee, First 3 Months
Floor Covering Handler Trainee, Second 3 Months

LOCALITIES: All localities within Alameda, Contra Costa, Lake, Marin, Mendocino, Monterey, San Benito, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, and Sonoma Counties.

DETERMINATIONS: ALA-2011-2, CON-2011-2, LAK-2011-2, MAR-2011-2, MEN-2011-2, MTY-2011-2, SBE-2011-2, NAP-2011-2, SFR-2011-2, SMA-2011-2, STC-2011-2, STZ-2011-2, SOL-2011-2 and SON-2011-2.

The predetermined increases effective January 1, 2013 and January 1, 2014 have been modified as follows:

Carpet, Linoleum, Soft Floor Layer:

- Effective January 1, 2013, there will be a \$0.25 increase allocated to Pension.
- Effective January 1, 2014, there will be a \$0.25 increase allocated to Pension.

Floor Covering Handler after 3 years:

- Effective January 1, 2013, there will be a \$0.13 increase allocated to Pension.
- Effective January 1, 2014, there will be a \$0.13 increase allocated to Pension.

Floor Covering Handler Less Than 3 Years:

- Effective January 1, 2013, there will be a \$0.10 increase allocated to Pension.
- Effective January 1, 2014, there will be a \$0.10 increase allocated to Pension.

Floor Covering Handler Trainee, First 3 Months:

- Effective January 1, 2013, there will be a \$0.08 increase allocated to Pension.
- Effective January 1, 2014, there will be a \$0.08 increase allocated to Pension.

Floor Covering Handler Trainee, Second 3 Months:

- Effective January 1, 2013, there will be a \$0.09 increase allocated to Pension.
- Effective January 1, 2014, there will be a \$0.09 increase allocated to Pension.

With the exception of the modifications stated above, all of the wage rates, overtime rates, and other conditions found in the above referenced determinations remain in effect.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES
REGARDING A MODIFICATION OF THE PREDETERMINED WAGE CHANGE IN THE
DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

Dear Public Official/Other Interested Parties:

The following is the modification of the predetermined change to the wages for the following craft and classification(s) listed below:

CRAFT/CLASSIFICATION: Carpet Linoleum Resilient Tile Layer (All shifts)
Material Handler After 6 months (All shifts)

DETERMINATION: INY-2011-2, KER-2011-2, LOS-2011-2, MON-2011-2, ORA-2011-2, RIV-2011-2, SBR-2011-2, SLO-2011-2, STB-2011-2, and VEN-2011-2

LOCALITIES: All localities within Inyo, Kern, Los Angeles, Mono, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, and Ventura Counties.

- The predetermined reallocation of \$0.35, from Training to Health and Welfare, scheduled to take effect on May 1, 2012 for **Carpet Linoleum Resilient Tile Layer (All shifts)** and **Material Handler After 6 months (All shifts)** has been deferred to January 1, 2013.

Effective January 1, 2013, \$0.35 will be reallocated from Training to Health and Welfare.

Material Handler After 6 Months is applicable only to Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, and Ventura Counties.

With the exception of the modification stated above, all of the wage rates and other conditions found in the above referenced determinations applicable to the above referenced craft/classification(s) remain unchanged.
