7                   **ARTICLE 9**  
8                   **HOLIDAYS**

9 **Art. 9(a)** The recognized holidays are: New Year's  
0 Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, July  
1 4th, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving  
2 Day, the day after Thanksgiving Day, and  
3 Christmas Day. If the Boilermakers and those  
4 crafts servicing the Boilermakers in a Local  
5 Building Trades Council elect to observe a  
6 holiday on a date other than that observed by  
7 the State or Nation, then that elected date shall  
8 be observed as the holiday. The Contractors  
9 shall be notified at least two weeks prior to the  
0 effective date of change.

1 **Art. 9(b)** Upon mutual agreement between  
2 the Local Union Business Manager  
3 and the Contractor Representative,  
4 Veterans Day may be changed for the day  
5 before Christmas.

6 **Art. 9(c)** No work shall be performed on  
7 Labor Day except for the preservation of  
8 life and property. When a holiday falls on  
9 a Saturday or Sunday, the day observed  
0 by the State or Nation shall be observed as  
1 the holiday.

1 Art. 9(d) Holidays falling on Tuesday,  
2 Wednesday, or Thursday may be observed  
3 on Monday or Friday where such is mutu-  
4 ally agreed to between a Contractor and  
5 the Local Union involved for an individual  
6 job site.
