REGARDING A MODIFICATION TO
THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

Dear Public Official/ Other Interested Parties:

CRAFT: Tile Finisher and Tile Finisher, 2nd Shift
LOCALITY: All localities within Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, San Joaquin, Stanislaus, and Tuolumne Counties.
DETERMINATIONS: ALP-2017-1, AMA-2017-1, CAL-2017-1, SJO-2017-1, STA-2017-1, and TUO-2017-1.

The predetermined increase of \$0.60 scheduled to take effect on October 1, 2017 has been reduced. The modified predetermined increases is as follows:

Effective October 1, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.40 to the Basic Hourly Rate and an increase of \$0.20 to Vacation/Holiday. There will be a decrease of \$0.60 to Other.

Effective April 1, 2018, there will be an increase of \$2.04 allocated to wages and/or fringes.

There will be no further increases applicable to these determinations.

With the exception of the above modification, all of the wage rates, and other conditions found in the above referenced determinations remain in effect.

CRAFT: Tile Finisher: Red Circled Finisher and Tile Finisher Red Circled Finisher, 2nd Shift
LOCALITY: All localities within Alpine, Amador, Calaveras, San Joaquin, Stanislaus, and Tuolumne Counties.
DETERMINATIONS: ALP-2017-1, AMA-2017-1, CAL-2017-1, SJO-2017-1, STA-2017-1, and TUE-2017-1.

The predetermined increase of \$0.60 scheduled to take effect on October 1, 2017 has been reduced. The modified predetermined increases is as follows:

Effective October 1, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.05 allocated as follows: an increase of \$0.59 to the Basic Hourly Rate and a decrease of \$0.54 to Other.

Effective April 1, 2018, there will be an increase of \$2.04 allocated to wages and/or fringes.

There will be no further increases applicable to these determinations.

With the exception of the above modification, all of the wage rates, and other conditions found in the above referenced determinations remain in effect.
