Any language not specifically addressed shall remain in effect through the duration of the Agreement.

1. The Collective Bargaining Agreement (expiring June 30, 2019) shall be extended through June 30, 2024.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) amends and extends the current Standard Form of Union Agreement (SFUA) and Addenda thereto and any MOUs or amendments in regard to this contract in effect at this time between the parties. Any language specifically not addressed shall remain in effect through the duration of the Agreement.

1. The Collective Bargaining Agreement shall be extended through June 30, 2019.

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5. Standardize holiday language. Eliminate SFUA Article VI, Section 2 Stockton language.  
~~"STOCKTON Only: For the Friday before Labor Day Holiday, if construction contracts or work compression demand that Employees work, Employees will work at the regular straight time rate. This includes any shop time related to that job.~~ (Note: Resolution 78 relief may be requested in this situation, at least 10 days prior to the holiday, to allow for Employer and Employee notice.)

Regarding: Separate Bargaining Sectors and the Counties Covered

To Whom It May Concern:

The recent consolidation of Collective Bargaining Agreements within the Sheet Metal Workers' Local 162 jurisdiction has created some unintended ambiguity when specific bargaining sectors are called out within the contract. For instance in Addendum 1, Item 16 Parking; there is specific reference to Sacramento and Stockton Only. This reference to a particular area of Northern California represents the Bargaining Unit, not just the specific City and will cover more than one County.

The Counties covered by each Bargaining Unit within Sheet Metal Workers' Local 162 as called out in the Collective Bargaining Agreement are listed below;

**Redding** – Butte, Glenn, Lassen, Modoc, Plumas, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou and Tehama Counties

**Sacramento** – Amador, Butte, Colusa, Eldorado, Glenn, Lassen, Modoc, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Sutter, Tehama, Yolo and Yuba Counties

**Stockton** – Alpine, Calaveras and San Joaquin Counties

**Modesto** – Merced, Stanislaus and Tuolumne Counties

**Fresno** – Fresno, Madera, and Kings Counties

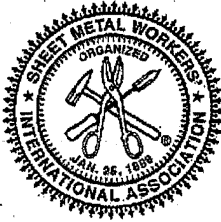


MODESTO Only; The overtime rate (for the first four (4) hours) of work over eight (8) hours per day during the regular work week, and for the first eight (8) hours on Saturdays and additional holidays shall be at time and one-half (1 1/2) the regular rate. All overtime in excess of the above will be at double (2) times the straight time rate. Sunday and the seven (7) named regular Holidays will be at double (2) times the regular straight time rate.

SECTION 2. New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, Presidents Day, Good Friday ( Sacramento and Redding only), Friday after Thanksgiving, Friday prior to Labor Day, or days locally observed as such , and Sunday shall be recognized as holidays. When any of the above mentioned holidays fall on a Saturday the Friday before shall be considered a legal holiday. If any of the above mentioned holidays fall on a Sunday, the Monday following shall be considered a legal holiday. Should New Years Day, the 4<sup>th</sup> of July or Christmas fall on a Tuesday, the preceding Monday shall be a holiday. If New Years Day, the 4<sup>th</sup> of July or Christmas fall on a Thursday, the following Friday shall be a holiday. All work performed on Holidays shall be paid at the double-time rate

STOCKTON Only; For the Friday before Labor Day Holiday, if construction contracts or work compression demands that Employees work, Employees will work at the regular straight time rate. This includes any shop time related to that job.

FRESNO only: If any of the above named holidays fall on a Thursday the following Friday shall be a holiday. If any of the above named holidays fall on a Tuesday the preceding Monday shall be a holiday. On the Friday prior to Labor Day, if any work is required on this holiday, the Union, via Resolution 78 will assist management in manning the job at straight time.
