MODESTO Only; The overtime rate (for the first four (4) hours) of work over eight (8) hours per day during the regular work week, and for the first eight (8) hours on Saturdays and additional holidays shall be at time and one-half (1 1/2) the regular rate. All overtime in excess of the above will be at double (2) times the straight time rate. Sunday and the seven (7) named regular Holidays will be at double (2) times the regular straight time rate.

SECTION 2. New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, Presidents Day, Good Friday (Sacramento and Redding only), Friday after Thanksgiving, Friday prior to Labor Day, or days locally observed as such, and Sunday shall be recognized as holidays. When any of the above mentioned holidays fall on a Saturday the Friday before shall be considered a legal holiday. If any of the above mentioned holidays fall on a Sunday, the Monday following shall be considered a legal holiday. Should New Years Day, the 4th of July or Christmas fall on a Tuesday, the preceding Monday shall be a holiday. If New Years Day, the 4th of July or Christmas fall on a Thursday, the following Friday shall be a holiday. All work performed on Holidays shall be paid at the double-time rate

<u>STOCKTON Only</u>; For the Friday before Labor Day Holiday, if construction contracts or work compression demands that Employees work, Employees will work at the regular straight time rate. This includes any shop time related to that job.

<u>FRESNO only</u>: If any of the above named holidays fall on a Thursday the following Friday shall be a holiday. If any of the above named holidays fall on a Tuesday the preceding Monday shall be a holiday. On the Friday prior to Labor Day, if any work is required on this holiday, the Union, via Resolution 78 will assist management in manning the job at straight time.
