104. When employees required to report to jobs, which are fifty-five (55) or more miles by the shortest and most direct regularly traveled route from the main office or field office of the Individual Employer, the employee, while traveling after the fifty-fifth (55th) miles, shall receive fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per hour and not subject to overtime or fringe benefits.
105. When an employee is required to remain away from home overnight, the Individual Employer shall provide lodging plus a minimum of \$20.00 for ordinary and necessary expenses for each night the employee is required to remain away from home. Effective July 1, 2017, this amount shall be increased to lodging plus a minimum of \$30.00 per night.
