INTERIM DETERMINATION FOR THE CRAFT OF PLUMBER: PLUMBER, STEAMFITTER[#]

Issue Date:

September 26, 2024

Expiration date of determination:

June 30, 2025* Effective until superseded by a new determination issued by the Director of Industrial Relations. Contact the Office of the Director – Research Unit at (415) 703-4774 for the new rates after ten days from the expiration date if no subsequent determination is issued.

Localities:

All localities within Amador (Portions North of Sutter Creek), El Dorado (Portions Lying Outside of Tahoe Basin Area), Nevada (Portion Lying Outside the Tahoe Basin), Placer (Portion Lying Outside the Tahoe Basin), Sacramento, and Yolo Counties.

This determination applies to projects advertised for bids on or after October 6, 2024. These rates supersede the Plumber: Plumber, Steamfitter rates issued in the General Prevailing Wage Determination: 2024-2 for Amador (Portions North of Sutter Creek), El Dorado (Portions Lying Outside of Tahoe Basin Area), Nevada (Portion Lying Outside the Tahoe Basin), Placer (Portion Lying Outside the Tahoe Basin), Sacramento, and Yolo Counties.

Recognized holidays:

Holidays upon which the general prevailing hourly wage rate for Holiday work shall be paid, shall be all holidays in the collective bargaining agreement, applicable to the particular craft, classification, or type of worker employed on the project, which is on file with the Director of Industrial Relations. If the prevailing rate is not based on a collectively bargained rate, the holidays upon which the prevailing rate shall be paid shall be as provided in Section 6700 of the Government Code. Travel and/or subsistence payment:

In accordance with Labor Code Sections 1773.1 and 1773.9, contractors shall make travel and/or subsistence payments to each worker to execute the work. ^c Rate applies to the first 2 daily overtime hours and the first 10 hours on Saturday; all other time is paid at the Sunday and Holiday Overtime Hourly Rate.

^d Pursuant to Labor Code Sections 1773.1 and 1773.8, the amount paid for this employer payment may vary resulting in a lower taxable basic hourly wage rate, but the total hourly rates for straight time and overtime may not be less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages.

° Rate applies to the first 2 daily overtime hours and the first 10 hours on Saturday; all other time is paid at the Sunday and Holiday Overtime Hourly Rate. Saturdays in the same work week may be worked at straight-time if job is shut down during the normal workweek due to inclement weather.

† Rate applies to the first 10 hours on Saturday if hours worked are under 40 hours per week. For work over 40 hours in one week, the Saturday rate is 1.5x the Basic Hourly Rate (no fringe benefits are included). All other time is paid at the Sunday and Holiday Overtime Hourly Rate. Saturdays in the same work week may be worked at straight-time if job is shut down during the normal workweek due to inclement weather.
