LOCALITIES: All localities within Imperial and San Diego Counties.

DETERMINATIONS: IMP-2026-1, SDI-2026-1

The predetermined increase scheduled to take effect on June 1, 2026, for the above-mentioned determinations has been reduced. The correct predetermined increase is as follows:

Effective June 1, 2026, there is an increase of \$2.35 allocated as follows: \$1.25 to Health & Welfare, \$1.00 to Pension, \$0.05 to Training, and \$0.05 to Other.

The predetermined increase scheduled to take effect on June 1, 2026, for the above-mentioned determination has been reduced. The correct predetermined increase is as follows:

Effective June 1, 2026, there is an increase of \$3.13 allocated as follows: \$0.75 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$1.25 to Health & Welfare, \$1.00 to Pension, \$0.05 to Training, \$0.05 to Other, and \$0.03 to NEBF.

Effective June 1, 2026, there is an increase of \$3.36 allocated as follows: \$0.98 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$1.25 to Health & Welfare, \$1.00 to Pension, \$0.05 to Training, \$0.05 to Other, and \$0.03 to NEBF.

Tunnel Cable Splicer for Electrical Projects of More Than \$5,000,000

The predetermined increase scheduled to take effect on June 1, 2026, for the above-mentioned determination has been reduced. The correct predetermined increase is as follows:

Effective June 1, 2026, there is an increase of \$3.21 allocated as follows: \$0.84 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$1.25 to Health & Welfare, \$1.00 to Pension, \$0.05 to Training, \$0.05 to Other, and \$0.02 to NEBF.

Tunnel Cable Splicer for Electrical Projects of More Than \$5,000,000 (Second Shift)

The predetermined increase scheduled to take effect on June 1, 2026, for the above-mentioned determination has been reduced. The correct predetermined increase is as follows:

Effective June 1, 2026, there is an increase of \$3.36 allocated as follows: \$0.98 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$1.25 to Health & Welfare, \$1.00 to Pension, \$0.05 to Training, \$0.05 to Other, and \$0.03 to NEBF.

Tunnel Cable Splicer for Electrical Projects of More Than \$5,000,000 (Third Shift)

The predetermined increase scheduled to take effect on June 1, 2026, for the above-mentioned determination has been reduced. The correct predetermined increase is as follows:

Effective June 1, 2026, there is an increase of \$3.48 allocated as follows: \$1.10 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$1.25 to Health & Welfare, \$1.00 to Pension, \$0.05 to Training, \$0.05 to Other, and \$0.03 to NEBF.

With the exception of these modifications, all of the wage rates and other conditions found in the above-referenced determinations remain unchanged.
