

TRAVEL AND SUBSISTENCE PROVISIONS

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Section 8. In the event there is not free parking available, for the employee, within ½ mile walking distance of the job site, then the Employer shall establish a fair and reasonable parking reimbursement, based on the local market rate, for daily parking. Such rate must be available within the ½ mile walking distance from the project site. To be reimbursed, the Employee shall provide paid receipts for reimbursement within seven (7) working days after the parking expense is incurred. Payment by the employer for parking shall be indicated separately on the worker's check stub. Parking receipts mailed to employer will be considered timely if postmarked no later than seven (7) working days after the parking expense is incurred.

Section 14. Except in the refractory industry, on all jobs more than ninety (90) miles from the employer's principal place of business as recognized by the California Contractors State License Board (CSLB), the employer shall pay a subsistence allowance of one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day. Effective May 1, 2027, the subsistence shall increase to one hundred-twenty dollars (\$120.00) per day for the remainder of the Agreement. On refractory jobs more than ninety (90) miles from the employee's residence, the employer shall pay a subsistence allowance on the same terms set forth in this section with respect to non-refractory jobs. After January 1, 2026, an employer shall be permitted to relocate its principal place of business for the purposes of this section only to a location that is owned or leased by the employer for a term of not less than twelve (12) months.

Article XVI

TRAVELING CONTRACTORS

When the employer has any work specified in Article II of this Agreement to be performed outside the area covered by this Agreement and within the area covered by an agreement with another affiliate of the International Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers, the Employer agrees to abide by the full Terms and Conditions of the Agreement in effect in the jobsite area. Employees covered by this agreement who are sent to projects outside of the area covered by this Agreement shall be paid the established minimum wage scale of the local Agreement covering the territory in which such work is being performed plus all contributions specified in the jobsite local Agreement. The Employer shall in all other matters be governed by provisions established in the jobsite local Agreement.
