Recognized holidays:

Holidays upon which the general prevailing hourly wage rate for Holiday work shall be paid, shall be all holidays in the collective bargaining agreement, applicable to the particular craft, classification, or type of worker employed on the project, which is on file with the Director of Industrial Relations. If the prevailing rate is not based on a collectively bargained rate, the holidays upon which the prevailing rate shall be paid shall be as provided in Section 6700 of the Government Code. Travel and/or subsistence payment:

^d Employed for 2000 hours (consecutively or cumulatively).

^e Daily overtime applies after 7 ½ hours worked at the straight-time rate for second shift and after 7 hours worked at the straight-time rate for third shift.

^f Rate applies to the first 4 overtime hours Monday through Friday and the first 7.5 hours on Saturday. All other time is paid at the Sunday and Holiday overtime rate. Saturdays may be worked at straight time if job is shut down during Monday through Friday due to inclement weather or major mechanical breakdown.

^g Time and one-half shall be paid for the first 7.5 hours worked on the four (4) days of each year selected by the Union as designated off/holidays listed in the Holiday Provision.

Saturdays may be worked at straight time if job is shut down during Monday through Friday due to inclement weather or major mechanical breakdown.

ⁱ Time and one-half shall be paid for the first 7 hours worked on the four (4) days of each year selected by the Union as designated off/holidays listed in the Holiday Provision.
