Recognized holidays:

Holidays upon which the general prevailing hourly wage rate for Holiday work shall be paid, shall be all holidays in the collective bargaining agreement, applicable to the particular craft, classification, or type of worker employed on the project, which is on file with the Director of Industrial Relations. If the prevailing rate is not based on a collectively bargained rate, the holidays upon which the prevailing rate shall be paid shall be as provided in Section 6700 of the Government Code. Travel and/or subsistence payment:

In accordance with Labor Code Sections 1773.1 and 1773.9, contractors shall make travel and/or subsistence payments to each worker to execute the work. Landscape/Irrigation Technician II, III and IV are not apprenticeable.

^a Includes an amount for supplemental dues.

^b Rate applies to first 4 daily overtime hours and the first 12 hours on Saturday. All other time is paid at the Sunday and Holiday double-time rate.

^c Saturdays in the same work week may be worked at straight-time if job is shut down during the normal work week due to inclement weather, major mechanical breakdown or lack of materials beyond the control of the employer.

^d The first employee on the job site will be Landscape/Irrigation Technician I. The second employee may be a Landscape/Irrigation Technician II or a Landscape/Irrigation Technician III. The third employee shall be a Landscape/Irrigation Technician IV, if a Landscape/Irrigation Technician III is not on the job site. Thereafter each employee may be a Landscape/Irrigation Technician II, III, or IV.
