HOLIDAYS

SECTION 2. New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, Presidents Day, Good Friday, Friday after Thanksgiving, Friday prior to Labor Day, Martin Luther King's Birthday, and the day after Christmas, or days locally observed as such, and Sunday shall be recognized as holidays. When any of the above mentioned holidays fall on a Saturday the Friday before shall be considered a legal holiday. If any of the above mentioned holidays fall on a Sunday, the Monday following shall be considered a legal holiday. Should New Year's Day, the 4th of July or Christmas fall on a Tuesday, the preceding Monday shall be a holiday. If New Year's Day, the 4th of July or Christmas fall on a Thursday, the following Friday shall be a holiday. All work performed on Holidays shall be paid at the double-time rate.

All other overtime work, including Sundays, holidays, shall be paid at the double time (2) rate. Additionally, the Saturday following Good Friday, Thanksgiving and the Saturday preceding Memorial Day and Labor Day shall be paid at the double time (2) rate.
