TRAVEL AND SUBSISTENCE

ARTICLE XV

SUBSISTENCE AND TRAVEL PAY PROVISIONS

1. DURING THE TERM OF THIS AGREEMENT THE SUBSISTENCE AND TRAVEL PAY provisions paid to Bricklayers within any portions of the geographical area covered by this Agreement shall be paid to Brick Tenders in the same amount as paid to Bricklayers within that specific geographical area. It is the intent of the parties that Brick Tenders and Bricklayers shall receive the same subsistence and travel pay allowances at all times during the term of this Agreement.

- A. IF, DURING THE TERM OF THIS AGREEMENT THE SUBSISTENCE AND TRAVEL PAY provisions paid to Bricklayers within any portions of the geographical area covered by this Agreement shall be increased, then in such portions of the geographical area so increased, the same increase shall be applicable to Brick Tenders. Except in the refractory industry, on all jobs more than ninety (90) miles from the employer's principal place of business as recognized by the California Contractors State License Board (CSLB), the employer shall pay a subsistence allowance of one-hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day. Effective July 1, 2027, the subsistence shall increase to one hundred- twenty dollars (\$120.00) per day for the remainder of the Agreement. On refractory jobs more than ninety (90) miles from the employee's residence, the employer shall pay a subsistence allowance on the same terms set forth in this section with respect to non-refractory jobs. After January 1, 2026, an employer shall be permitted to relocate its principal place of business for the purposes of this section only to a location that is owned or leased by the employer for a term of not less than twelve (12) months. If the Bricklayer Subsistence Rules are adjusted, the Association may request a revision to this Brick Tender Agreement.

Any increase as described above shall automatically become a portion of this Agreement and no further amendment or writing shall be necessary in order to effectuate such increase.

- B. ON ANY MILITARY BASE WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THIS AGREEMENT, where the Bricklayers Agreement provides for a wage differential in lieu of subsistence and/or travel pay allowances, the Brick Tenders shall also receive the wage differential in lieu of subsistence and/or travel pay.

ARTICLE XVI

A. JOBSITE TRANSPORTATION. Whenever there are remote areas, hazardous road conditions or security restrictions, the Contractor is required to furnish transportation for men within the jobsite to the place of their "work."

B. PARKING FACILITIES. In the event there is no free parking available for the employee within ½ mile walking distance of the job site, then the Contractor shall establish a fair and reasonable parking reimbursement, based on the local market rate, for daily parking. Such rate must be available within the ½ mile walking distance from the project site. To be reimbursed, the Employee shall provide paid receipts for reimbursement within seven (7) working days after the parking expense is incurred. Payment by the employer for parking shall be indicated separately on the worker's check stub. Parking receipts mailed to employer will be considered timely if postmarked no later than seven (7) working days after the parking expense is incurred.
