**MINUTES OF APRIL 30, 2014 MEETING:**

1. EXPEDITED PROCEEDINGS:

The report, which will be posted to the OSHAB website, illustrates that, through April 30, 155 cases were placed into Expedited Proceedings since the regulation took effect on July 1, 2013. The report also indicates that 42% of cases placed into Expedited Proceedings were abated within the first 30 days, about 80% within 90 days. Abatement status of each case is reported to OSHAB by the DOSH District Managers.

1. DOCUMENT RETENTION POLICY PROJECT:

ACTION: Analyst McKeever reported that OSHAB received approval from DIR, the State Records Program (CalRIM), and the State Archives for its new document retention policy. The new policy calls for OSHAB to archive case files and records for three years. As a result of the new policy, Analyst McKeever has begun to destroy outdated orders and decisions of Administrative Law Judges. These outdated documents are contained within more than 400 binders, which will be recycled, sold or donated in the coming weeks.

The next step in the Document Retention project is to identify appropriate retention periods for additional records kept at the Appeals Board, such as old correspondence, personnel records, financial records and other documents.
