**MINUTES OF JUNE 25, 2014 MEETING:**

*(Approve or amend minutes of previous Board meeting)*

ACTION: Member Lowry moved that the Board approve the draft minutes of the June 25, 2014 Board meeting. Member Freyman seconded. The Board voted to approve the draft minutes of the June 25, 2014 Board meeting.

**ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS:**

Chair Carter reported that the next meeting, on July 23, 2014, will be held at 1:30 p.m. instead of the usual 9:30 a.m.

**EXPEDITED PROCEEDINGS:**

*(Report on general administration of expedited proceedings)*

ACTION: The Board reviewed the statistics from the first year of expedited cases resulting from the Expedited Proceedings regulation which took effect on July 1. During that time frame, the Board received 1223 serious cases. After review by the analysts, 176 cases met the criteria under the regulation and were scheduled as Expedited Proceedings. Of those cases, 70 abated before 30 days from docketing, and another 55 cases abated between 30 and 90 days from docketing.

Members of the public requested additional explanation of the statistics graphic, which is posted on the OSHAB website each month. The graphic attempts to measure the time that it takes for cases to enter and complete Expedited Proceedings. It was suggested that the graphic could be improved if an additional column was added to include the number of serious cases received each month (the current graphic includes the “year to date” total of serious cases). Additional suggestions for measuring the effects of the expedited regulations were offered by members of the public and the Board will consider the feasibility of tracking cases as suggested. Board staff explained that cooperation from other DIR units is required for this expanded data set. The Board expressed a desire to provide this additional information if possible.

**DOCUMENT RETENTION POLICY PROJECT:**

**ACTION:** The Board amended its policy for dealing with storage of Decisions and Orders of Administrative Law Judges. The staff is currently inventorying its remaining stored materials to determine a retention schedule for items not pertaining to cases before the Board.

EO Johnson is still working with the DOSH staff to reschedule hearings and prehearings that were previously scheduled during that time period.
