



Why focus on schools?

The education industry has very low levels of fatalities but *higher levels of injuries and illnesses* than workers in other industries.

For school districts, risk managers, HR, department heads, union representatives and other workers.

Helps schools develop an effective comprehensive health and safety plan



Schools are workplaces too!
School employees are more likely to get injured on the job than the average California worker.

United for Safety

To prevent injuries:

1. Look for hazards in your job and work with others to identify solutions that will work best for you. Go to www.dir.ca.gov/CHSWC/SASH to find tips and solutions to address common hazards.
2. Report hazards to your district or school's safety coordinator or to your supervisor. Show your ideas for solutions. Remember, you have a right to a safe workplace.





Caused by Student Behaviors

Evaluation: 83% of participants reported that the class exceeded or *greatly* exceeded their expectations

Taking Action 2 months after class
