ELECTRICIAN CURRICULUM CERTIFICATION COMMITTEE MEETING

MINUTES

Wednesday – June 16, 2010 9:00 A.M.

I. Call To Order/ Roll Call

Acting Chief Glen Forman called the meeting to order at 9:20 A.M.

Members present: Glen Forman, Barry Noonan, and John Dunn

A quorum was met.

II. Review/approval of September 24, 2009 Minutes

- After reviewing the minutes of the previous meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by John Dunn; the motion was then seconded by Barry Noonan. The motion to accept the minutes as written was approved.

III. Community College Approvals

- Orange County IBW – a site visit was made by IEBW representative. Dr. Noonan contacted IBW and the suggested improvements have not been complete. This will be brought back to the agenda upon their completion.

IV. CDE Approvals

- City Wide Electronic Systems, Inc. – Continuing Education provider only.
 - Have been approved.
 - Mr. Forman reported that the list of Continuing Education providers should be on the DAS website by next week.
- Durosseau Electrical Institute – Los Angeles
 - Have been approved.
 - Mr. Dunn made a motion to approve Durosseau Electrical Institute with the understanding either they have an OSHA Certified Trainer on staff doing the OSHA training or have access to an OSHA Certified Trainer. Dr. Noonan seconded the motion. The motion was carried.
 - Non-residential Lighting Technician crosswalk
Mr. Dunn reported that Mr. Jack Yap, California Electrical Training has been working on curriculum and asked the committee to give him feedback on how to proceed. Mr. Forman stated that research will be done to determine if the committee has the authority to approve a crosswalk for Non-residential Lighting Technician and bring it back to the next meeting.

V. AB2523

- Dr. Noonan wanted to discuss the status of the AB2523 where the WECA/IBW can take care of their own electrician training without an LEA. Dr. Noonan reported that he put together a conference call together with the community colleges and unions to discuss and answer any questions regarding ABA2523. Dr. Noonan stated that the Chancellor's Office has not taken a position. After much discussion, Dr. Noonan adjourned the meeting after he was assured that there were no further questions or concerns. He further reported that the negotiation process has gone forward and the current proposals will go in to amend the original bill.
