

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE
Labor Code section 273

I/We, the undersigned applicant(s), for

- Licensure as a farm labor contractor;
- Registration as a garment manufacturer;
- Renewal or reinstatement of a farm labor contractor license or a garment manufacturer registration; or
- A change in the persons identified pursuant to Section 1689 or subparagraph (B) of paragraph (1) of subdivision (a) of Section 2675

Certify and acknowledges that I/we:

- Are aware of the provisions of Labor Code 273;
- Have satisfied all requirements imposed by a final judgment issued by a court or by a final order issued by the Labor Commissioner or by an accord involving unpaid wages;
- Are aware that any person who knowingly provides false information in this statement is subject to a civil penalty of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1000) and no more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), in addition to any civil remedies available to the Labor Commissioner;
- If the Labor Commissioner determines after granting an application that the applicant made a false representation on the statement, the Labor Commissioner shall suspend the license or registration under conditions specific in Labor Code section 273(d) are met;
- The Labor Commissioner shall not approve an application if the statement shows that the applicant has failed to satisfy all the requirements imposed by a final judgment issued by a court or by a final order issued by the Labor Commissioner or by an accord unless the applicant submits either of the following to the Labor Commissioner:
 - A bond or a cash deposit in an amount sufficient to guarantee payment of all amounts due under a final judgment or
 - A notarized accord between the applicant and the other parties to the judgment, order or accord demonstrating that the applicant has satisfied all requirements imposed by the judgment, order or accord;
- Are required to notify the Labor Commissioner within 90 days of the date of any final judgment, order or accord involving unpaid wages; and
- Shall not allow a person who is a judgment debtor in a final judgment or order involving unpaid wages that have not been satisfied in their entirety to serve in a capacity described in Section 1689 or subparagraph (B) of paragraph (1) of subdivision (a) of Section 2675.
