Labor Code §1700.44(c) states that "no action or proceeding shall be brought [under the Talent Agencies Act] with respect to any violation which is alleged to have occurred more than one year prior to the commencement of the proceeding."

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
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The alleged violations herein took place more than one year prior to the filing of this petition. Consequently, the petition is hereby dismissed on the ground that it is barred by the statute of limitations.


