SAFETY / TRAINING OVERVIEW

- Initiation / On-Boarding
 - Several Different Approaches
 - Week-Long Training Program
 - Job Shadow / Reserve Shadow
 - Team Rotations
- Safety Focus
 - Several Different Approaches
 - Significant Initial Focus
 - Weekly Meeting Focus
 - Monthly / Quarterly Reinforcement
 - Injury / Re-Focus



SAFETY INTEGRATION

- Safety Standardization
 - Minimizes Omissions
- Integration into Safety Committees
 - Provides Venue for Suggestions
 - Corporate-Wide Support
 - Proven Feedback Loop



HOUSEKEEPING SAFETY

- Safety & Training is Working!
 - Injury Rate at 5.1 per 100 (2011)
 - 8.9% Reduction in Injuries Since 2008
 - Injury Rate 57.8% Less Than Janitors/Maids
