**NOTICE OF REVISION OF ECONOMIC IMPACT  
ASSESSMENT/ANALYSIS  
AND DISCLOSURE REGARDING THE PROPOSED RULEMAKING**

The economic impact assessment/analysis contained in the initial statement of reasons for this rulemaking and the disclosure regarding the proposed rulemaking contained in the notice of proposed rulemaking for this rulemaking estimated that this rulemaking will result in approximately 150 to 180 additional "Repeat" citations issued in California annually. Due to the modifications of the text contained in this notice, the Director is revising this estimate to 250 to 300 additional "Repeat" citations that could be issued in California annually as a result of this rulemaking.
