**ADDENDUM TO FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS AND
UPDATED INFORMATIVE DIGEST**

Subject Matter of Regulations: Utilization Review Enforcement

**TITLE 8, CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS
SECTIONS 9792.11 – 9792.15**

In addition to the changes and responses to comments set forth in the final statement of reasons, the Acting Administrative Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation sets forth the following:

**THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS WERE AMENDED FOLLOWING THE
SUBMISSION OF THE RULEMAKING BINDER TO THE OFFICE OF
ADMINISTRATIVE LAW:**

Punctuation and numbering corrections were made throughout regulations (sections 9792.11 – 9792.15). Syntax corrections were also made to some subdivisions for clarity.

**Section 9792.11 – Investigation Procedures: Labor Code §4610 Utilization Review
Violations**

In subdivisions (a), (c), and (i), the words “these regulations” were replaced with “sections 9792.11 through 9792.15” for clarity.

In subdivision (c) and (e), the word “credible” was deleted for clarity.

In subdivision (e) the word “sample” was inserted before “form” to clarify that use of the form is not mandatory.

**Section 9792.12 – Administrative Penalty Schedule for Labor Code §4610
Utilization Review Violations**

In subdivisions (b)(1)(E), (b)(2), and (c), citation to the specific penalties by subdivision number was added for clarity.

STATEMENT RE RESPONSES TO COMMENTS:

The document "Annual Audit Report for 2006" quoted in the response to comments regarding 9792.11(c)(1)(B) was not relied on, but the quote was provided to illustrate that the referenced rate setting process would not work in the utilization review administrative penalty context.
