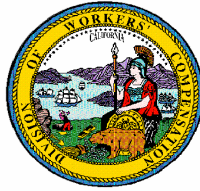

**Order of the Administrative Director of the Division of Workers'
Compensation Official Medical Fee Schedule Durable
Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, Supplies
Effective for Services Rendered on or after January 1, 2015**

Pursuant to Labor Code section 5307.1(g)(2), the Administrative Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation orders that the Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, Supplies portion of the Official Medical Fee Schedule contained in title 8, California Code of Regulations, section 9789.60, is adjusted to conform to changes to the Medicare payment system that were adopted by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services for calendar year 2015.

Medicare Data Source and Incorporation by Reference

Effective for services rendered on or after January 1, 2015, the maximum reasonable fees for Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics, Orthotics, Supplies shall not exceed 120% of the applicable California fees set forth in the Medicare calendar year 2015 "Durable Medical Equipment, Prosthetics/Orthotics, and Supplies (DMEPOS) Fee Schedule" revised for January 2015, contained in the electronic file "[DME15-A \[ZIP, 2MB\]](#)" which is incorporated by reference. The update includes all changes identified in CR 8999. [The CMS Manual System, Pub 100-4 Medicare Claims Processing, Transmittal 3129, Change Request 8999](#), November 21, 2014 sets forth the changes and is relied upon in adopting this update Order.
