MAXIMUS Federal Services has completed the Independent Bill Review (“IBR”) of the above Workers’ Compensation case. This letter provides you with the IBR Final Determination and explains how the determination was made.

**Final Determination: OVERTURN. MAXIMUS Federal Services has determined that additional reimbursement is warranted. The Claims Administrator’s determination is reversed and the Claim Administrator owes the Provider additional reimbursement of \$195.00 for the review cost and \$128.45 in additional reimbursement for a total of \$323.45. A detailed explanation of the decision is provided later in this letter.**

The Claim Administrator is required to reimburse the Provider a total of **\$323.45** within 45 days of the date on this letter per section 4603.2 (2a) of the California Labor Code. The determination of MAXIMUS Federal Services and its expert reviewer is deemed to be the Final Determination of the Administrative Director of the Division of Workers’ Compensation. This determination is binding on all parties. In certain limited circumstances, you can appeal the Final Determination. Appeals must be filed with the Workers’ Compensation Appeals Board within 20 days from the date of this letter. For more information on appealing the final determination, please see California Labor Code Section 4603.6(f).

## **HOW THE IBR FINAL DETERMINATION WAS MADE**

MAXIMUS Federal Services Chief Coding Specialist reviewed the case file and researched pertinent coding and billing standards to reach a determination. In some cases a physician reviewer was employed to review the clinical aspects of the care to help make a determination. He/she has no affiliation with the employer, employee, providers or the claims administrator. The expert reviewer was selected based on his/her clinical experience, education, background, and expertise in the same or similar specialties that evaluate and/or treat the medical condition and disputed items/services.

## ANALYSIS AND FINDING

Based on review of the case file the following is noted:

- **ISSUE IN DISPUTE: Provider seeking \$232.78 in additional remuneration for 97140 Manual therapy techniques (eg, mobilization/ manipulation, manual lymphatic drainage, manual traction), 1 or more regions, each 15 minutes, submitted for dates of service 06/11/2015 through 07/28/2015.**
- The Claims Administrator's reimbursement rational indicates "Scheduled Allowance."
- Contractual Agreement indicates 100% OMFS.
- IBR Assignment indicates dates of service 06/18/2015 through 08/13/2015. However, the UB-04 and Physical Therapist Visit Documentation only reflect the following dates of service: 06/17, 06/19, 07/01, 07/08, 07/10, 07/22 and 07/24/2015, For this reason, only these 7 dates of services will be addressed and reviewed.
- **CPT 97140 PC/TC indicator of "7."** Physical therapy service, for which payment may not be made--Payment may not be made if the service is provided to either a patient in a hospital outpatient department or to an inpatient of the hospital **by an independently practicing physical or occupational therapist.**
  - **UB-04 Does not Indicate Physical Therapist in Private Practice**
  - **Visit Documentation reflects one Physical Therapist for each date of service with no indication the Physical Therapist of Record is in Private Practice.**
- UB-04 indicates 97140 subject to MPPR.
- **CCR § 9789.32 (c)** The maximum allowable fees for services, drugs and supplies furnished by hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers that do not meet the requirements in (a) for a facility fee payment and are not bundled in the APC payment rate for services in (a) will be determined as follows:
  - (1)(A) For services rendered before September 1, 2014, the maximum allowable hospital outpatient facility fees for **professional medical services which are performed by physicians and other licensed health care providers to hospital outpatients** shall be paid according to Section 9789.10 and Section 9789.11.
  - **(B) For Other Services** rendered on or after September 1, 2014 to hospital outpatients, the maximum allowable hospital outpatient facility fees shall be paid according to the OMFS RBRVS.
    - (i) If the Other Service has a Professional Component/Technical Component under the OMFS RBRVS, the hospital outpatient facility fee shall be the Technical Component amount determined according to the OMFS RBRVS.
    - (ii) For Other Services, which do not meet the requirement in (i), the hospital outpatient facility fee shall be determined based solely on the non-facility practice expense relative value units applicable under the OMFS RBRVS.
    - **(iii) The fees for any physician and non-physician practitioner professional services billed by the hospital shall be calculated in accordance with the OMFS RBRVS, using the OMFS RBRVS total facility relative value units.**
