### CLINICAL CASE SUMMARY

The expert reviewer developed the following clinical case summary based on a review of the case file, including all medical records:

The injured worker is a 51 year old male, who sustained an industrial injury on 06-10-2014. On provider visit dated 06-02-2015 the injured worker has reported pain. On examination the left shoulder decreased range of motion and strength was most noted. Positive Neer's sign of the left shoulder. The diagnoses have included left shoulder impingement syndrome. Treatment to date has included medication and injections. The provider requested left shoulder manipulation under anesthesia and diagnostic left shoulder arthroscopy with subacromial decompression, post-operative physical therapy, pre-operative clearance for history and physical, pre-operative electromyocardiogram, pre-operative chest X-ray and pre-operative laboratory studies.

### IMR ISSUES, DECISIONS AND RATIONALES

The Final Determination was based on decisions for the disputed items/services set forth below:

**Left Shoulder Manipulation under Anesthesia and Diagnostic Left Shoulder Arthroscopy with Subacromial Decompression:** Upheld

**Claims Administrator guideline:** The Claims Administrator did not base their decision on the MTUS. Decision based on Non-MTUS Citation Official Disability Guidelines (ODG), Treatment Index, 11th Edition (web), 2015, Shoulder Manipulation under anesthesia (MUA), Low Back, Adhesiolysis, percutaneous.

**MAXIMUS guideline:** The Expert Reviewer did not base their decision on the MTUS. Decision based on Non-MTUS Citation Official Disability Guidelines (ODG) Shoulder.

**Decision rationale:** CA MTUS/ACOEM is silent on the issue of surgery for adhesive capsulitis. Per ODG shoulder section, the clinical course of this condition is self-limiting. There is insufficient literature to support capsular distention, arthroscopic lysis of adhesions/capsular release or manipulation under anesthesia (MUA). The requested procedure is not recommended by the guidelines and therefore is not medically necessary.

**Post op Physical Therapy 2 x 8:** Upheld
