### HOW THE IMR FINAL DETERMINATION WAS MADE

The expert reviewer was selected based on his/her clinical experience, education, background, and expertise in the same or similar specialties that evaluate and/or treat the medical condition and disputed items/Service. He/she is familiar with governing laws and regulations, including the strength of evidence hierarchy that applies to Independent Medical Review determinations.

### CLINICAL CASE SUMMARY

The expert reviewer developed the following clinical case summary based on a review of the case file, including all medical records:

This 25 year old woman sustained an industrial injury on 11/1/2012. The mechanism of injury is not detailed. Diagnoses include cervical spine sprain/strain, cervical spine radiculopathy, right shoulder subacromial bursitis and impingement, right elbow lateral epicondylitis, and right shoulder partial rotator cuff tear. Treatment has included oral medications, home exercise program, activity modification, and physical therapy. Physician notes dated 5/21/2015 show complaints of cervical spine pain rated 7/10 with radiation to the right upper extremity, right shoulder pain rated 6/10, and right elbow pain rated 5/10. Recommendations include surgical intervention, additional physical therapy, continue home exercise program, Soma, Hydrocodone, urine drug screen, and follow up in four weeks.

### IMR ISSUES, DECISIONS AND RATIONALES

The Final Determination was based on decisions for the disputed items/services set forth below:

**Right Shoulder Arthroscopy, outpatient:** Upheld

**Claims Administrator guideline:** Decision based on MTUS ACOEM Chapter 9 Shoulder Complaints.

**MAXIMUS guideline:** The Expert Reviewer did not base their decision on the MTUS. Decision based on Non-MTUS Citation Official Disability Guidelines (ODG) shoulder.

**Decision rationale:** According to the CA MTUS/ACOEM Shoulder Chapter, page 209-210, surgical considerations for the shoulder include failure of four months of activity modification and existence of a surgical lesion. The ODG shoulder section, acromioplasty surgery recommends 3-6 months of conservative care plus a painful arc of motion from 90-130 degrees. In addition night pain and weak or absent abduction must be present. There must be tenderness over the rotator cuff or anterior acromial area and positive impingement signs with temporary relief from anesthetic injection. In this case the exam note from 5/21/15 does not demonstrate evidence satisfying the above criteria notably the relief with anesthetic injection. Therefore the request does not adhere to guideline recommendations and is not medically necessary.

**Pre operative blood work: CMP (comprehensive metabolic panel)/ eGFR:** Upheld

**Claims Administrator guideline:** The Claims Administrator did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**MAXIMUS guideline:** The Expert Reviewer did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**Decision rationale:** Since the primary procedure is not medically necessary, none of the associated services are medically necessary.

**Pre operative blood work: PT (pro thrombin):** Upheld

**Claims Administrator guideline:** The Claims Administrator did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**MAXIMUS guideline:** The Expert Reviewer did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**Decision rationale:** Since the primary procedure is not medically necessary, none of the associated services are medically necessary.

**Pre operative blood work: UA (urinalysis) / RfICul:** Upheld

**Claims Administrator guideline:** The Claims Administrator did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**MAXIMUS guideline:** The Expert Reviewer did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**Decision rationale:** Since the primary procedure is not medically necessary, none of the associated services are medically necessary.

**Pre operative blood work: CBC (complete blood count)/ Differential:** Upheld

**Claims Administrator guideline:** The Claims Administrator did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**MAXIMUS guideline:** The Expert Reviewer did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**Decision rationale:** Since the primary procedure is not medically necessary, none of the associated services are medically necessary.

**Pre operative blood work: APTT:** Upheld

**MAXIMUS guideline:** The Expert Reviewer did not cite any medical evidence for its decision.

**Decision rationale:** Since the primary procedure is not medically necessary, none of the associated services are medically necessary.
