The Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) Medical Unit is now accepting applications for the qualified medical evaluator (QME) examination, which will take place on Saturday, Apr. 28, 2007. The deadline for filing exam applications is Mar. 8, 2007. QMEs are independent physicians certified by the DWC Medical Unit to conduct medical evaluations of injured workers.

An exam site in Southern California and one in Northern California will be chosen about a month prior to the exam date, once the number of applicants is determined.
