**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification, or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 26, 2024, Cara Weese-Cooper's license, certification, or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the California Board of Registered Nursing, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, on or about July 8, 2025, the Administrative Director mailed to Cara Weese-Cooper a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Cara Weese-Cooper that the suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Cara Weese-Cooper submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

WHEREAS, Cara Weese-Cooper did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

1           WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,  
2 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of  
3 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was  
4 mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a  
5 hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;

6           **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent Cara Weese-Cooper is hereby  
7 suspended from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician,  
8 practitioner, or provider.
