Dear Ms. Cox:

The initial approval of the Madera Unified School District Labor Compliance Program, ID No. 2003.00175 is withdrawn, effective July 27, 2009. This action is based on the program's failure to meet the updating requirements for continued approval status, as specified in Title 8, California Code of Regulations, section 16425(f). Specifically, the program has failed to file a timely Annual Report in accordance with the requirements of section 16431 of the regulations.

The program may reapply for approval but must submit a new and complete application pursuant to sections 16424 and 16425 of the regulations. The school district can also contract with an approved third party labor compliance program in order to meet the requirements of Labor Code Section 1771.7 [AB 1506] or any other state statute that requires the district to have or contract for a labor compliance program.
