Dear Mr. Bridges:

In accordance with the provisions of Title 8, California Code of Regulations, section 16427, request for extended authority of the Labor Compliance Program (LCP) of the Ocean View School District is denied. This action is based on the program's failure to establish its ability and capacity to operate an effective labor compliance program in accordance with applicable legal requirements. In particular, the lack of experience and training among the program personnel of the Ocean View School District's Labor Compliance Program that demonstrates the understanding and ability to perform labor compliance monitoring. In addition, the program's manual remains inadequate and fully up-to-date. As a likely result of the lack of formal training of the program personnel in the areas of labor compliance monitoring, the School District has not been able to properly update its manual after several attempts.

Because the district is no longer approved to operate a LCP, in order to meet the LCP requirement of Labor Code section 1771.7, or any similar statute for currently on-going projects of the district, the district will need to contract with an approved third party program. We would also like to call your attention to the current rulemaking proceeding to amend existing LCP regulations and adopt new regulations to implement the recent SBX2-9 legislation. Once these proposals become effective, they may significantly limit the manner in which awarding bodies may use third party LCPs to enforce state prevailing wage requirements. 
