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**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES & ALL INTERESTED PARTIES  
 REGARDING CHANGES TO THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

**PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATION FOR THE CRAFT OF #FIELD SURVEYOR**

The following prevailing wage rates for the above referenced craft are the predetermined changes which were inadvertently omitted from the 2006-1 general determinations. These prevailing wage rates apply to projects advertised for bids on or after March 4, 2006. With the exception of the changes below, there are no changes to the apprenticeship schedule, IMP-2006-1, INY-2006-1, KER-2006-1, LOS-2006-1, MON-2006-1, ORA-2006-1, RIV-2006-1, SBR-2006-1, SDI-2006-1, SLO-2006-1, STB-2006-1, and VEN-2006-1.

**Issue Date:** February 22, 2006

**Expiration date of determination:** September 30, 2006\*\* The rate to be paid for work performed after this date has been determined. If work will extend past this date, the new rate must be paid and should be incorporated in contracts entered into now. **Localities:** All localities within Imperial, Inyo, Kern, Los Angeles, Mono, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, and Ventura Counties.

- *Chief of Party - \$1.95 to wages and/or fringes; Instrumentman - \$1.90 to wages and/or fringes; Chainman/Rodman - \$1.90 to wages and/or fringes. There are no further increases applicable to this interim determination.*

<sup>c</sup>Employee receives an amount equal to 2% of the preceding year's straight-time hourly earnings after one year of continuous service for the employer; an amount equal to 4% of the preceding year's straight-time hourly earnings is paid after 2 years of continuous service; an amount equal to 6% of the preceding year's straight-time hourly earnings is paid after 10 years of continuous service. When an employee is terminated prior to having 1 year of service, 2% of his accumulated straight-time earnings shall be paid. Workers receive 8 paid holidays per year.

<sup>d</sup>Rate applies to the first 4 daily overtime hours and the first 12 hours worked on Saturday. All other time is paid at the Sunday overtime hourly rate. Rate does not include Vacation/Holiday. Please see footnote for Vacation/Holiday payment
