PREDETERMINED INCREASE FOR
TUNNEL WORKER (LABORER) (SC-23-102-12-2007-1)

IN IMPERIAL, INYO, KERN, LOS ANGELES, MONO, ORANGE, RIVERSIDE,
SAN BERNARDINO, SAN LUIS OBISPO, SANTA BARBARA, AND VENTURA
COUNTIES

This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the current determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after March 4, 2007 until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

TUNNEL WORKER (LABORER):

Determination SC-23-102-12-2007-1 is currently in effect and expires on June 30, 2007**.

Effective July 1, 2007, there was an increase of \$2.25 allocated as follows: \$2.04 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.05 to Vacation & Holiday (\$0.04 to Vac/\$0.01 to Supplemental Dues) and \$0.16 to Training.

Effective July 1, 2008, there was an increase of \$2.25 to be allocated as follows: \$1.70 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.10 to Health and Welfare, \$0.39 to Vacation and Holiday (\$0.17 to Supplemental Dues), \$0.05 to Other payments, and \$0.01 to Training.

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
