**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES
AND ALL INTERESTED PARTIES REGARDING MODIFICATIONS
TO THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

Dear Public Official/ Other Interested Parties:

The following are modifications of the predetermined increases for the craft/classification(s) listed below:

CRAFT/CLASSIFICATIONS: Carpet, Linoleum, Soft Floor Layer
Floor Covering Handler after 3 years
Floor Covering Handler Less Than 3 Years
Floor Covering Handler Trainee, First 3 Months
Floor Covering Handler Trainee, Second 3 Months

LOCALITIES: All localities within Alameda, Contra Costa, Lake, Marin, Mendocino, Monterey, San Benito, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, and Sonoma Counties.

DETERMINATIONS: ALA-2011-2, CON-2011-2, LAK-2011-2, MAR-2011-2, MEN-2011-2, MTY-2011-2, SBE-2011-2, NAP-2011-2, SFR-2011-2, SMA-2011-2, STC-2011-2, STZ-2011-2, SOL-2011-2 and SON-2011-2.

Effective on January 1, 2012, the following predetermined wage increases have been reduced:

- The predetermined increase of \$1.50 for **Carpet, Linoleum, Soft Floor Layer** has been reduced to \$0.62 (\$0.37 to Health & Welfare and \$0.25 to Pension)
- The predetermined increase of \$0.75 for **Floor Covering Handler after 3 years** has been reduced to \$0.50 (\$0.37 to Health & Welfare and \$0.13 to Pension)
- The predetermined increase of \$0.60 for **Floor Covering Handler Less Than 3 Years** has been reduced to \$0.47 (\$0.37 to health & Welfare and \$0.10 to Pension)
- The predetermined increase of \$0.48 for **Floor Covering Handler Trainee, First 3 Months** has been reduced to \$0.45 (\$0.37 to Health & Welfare and \$0.08 to Pension)
- The predetermined increase of \$0.54 for **Floor Covering Handler Trainee, Second 3 Months** has been reduced to \$0.46 (\$0.37 to Health & Welfare and \$0.09 to Pension)
