INTERIM DETERMINATION FOR THE CRAFT OF #DRYWALL FINISHER

Issue Date: November 4, 2013

Expiration date of Determination: December 31, 2013* Effective until superseded by a new determination issued by the Director of Industrial Relations. Locality: San Diego County

This determination applies to projects advertised for bids on or after November 14, 2013. These rates supersede the Drywall Finisher wage rates issued in the SDI-2013-2 General Prevailing Wage Determinations.

RECOGNIZED HOLIDAYS: Holidays upon which the general prevailing hourly wage rate for Holiday work shall be paid, shall be all holidays in the collective bargaining agreement, applicable to the particular craft, classification, or type of worker employed on the project, which is on file with the Director of Industrial Relations. If the prevailing rate is not based on a collectively bargained rate, the holidays upon which the prevailing rate shall be paid shall be as provided in Section 6700 of the Government Code.
