PREDETERMINED INCREASE FOR
METAL ROOFING SYSTEMS INSTALLER
(Determination C-MR-2015-1)

IN ALL LOCALITIES WITHIN ALAMEDA, CONTRA COSTA,
MENDOCINO AND SOLANO COUNTIES

This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the above referenced determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after **September 1, 2015**, until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

Determination C-MR-2015-1 is in effect and expires on July 31, 2016**

Effective August 1, 2016, there was an increase of \$0.79 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.91 to Health & Welfare and \$0.30 to Pension.

Effective August 1, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.25 to Health & Welfare, \$0.30 to Pension and \$1.45 to be allocated to wages and/or employer payments.

Effective August 1, 2018, there will be an increase of \$0.25 to Health & Welfare, \$0.30 to Pension and \$1.45 to be allocated to wages and/or employer payments.

Effective August 1, 2019, there will be an increase of \$0.55 to Health & Welfare and \$1.45 allocated to be allocated to wages and/or employer payments.

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
